ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

Background:

The Division is committed to fostering policies, practices and educational programs that will protect and preserve the environment.

Procedures:

- 1. The Division shall endeavour to purchase "environmentally friendly" products providing the highest possible level of health, safety and performance.
- 2. The Division shall endeavour to operate school facilities and equipment in the most energy efficient manner consistent with human needs for safety and comfort.
 - 2.1. The Division encourages employees to practice energy conservation measures.
 - 2.2. The Director of Facility Services or designate shall keep in order a monitoring system of energy utilization.
 - 2.3. Efficient use of energy and water shall be considerations for renovations, new construction and operations.
- 3. The Division encourages and supports initiatives to reduce, recycle and reuse waste materials and responsible disposal of hazardous waste.
- 4. The Division supports staff development initiatives designed to advance environmental awareness, environmental education and care for the environment within each department's annual budget allocations for training and development.
- 5. The Division shall promote local habitat conservation and improvement on Division-owned properties, where possible.
- 6. All new school facilities, additions to facilities and renovation projects shall meet, at minimum, the prescriptive sustainable requirements as noted above. All projects shall be certified to a minimum LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) silver rating.
