Elections can generate a large amount of waste during the campaign trail. Below is a list of tips to consider, from signs to promotional giveaways to zero-waste events, we're here to help.

Are my election signs recyclable?

Coroplast is easily recycled and can be put in the plastics bin at the Broadview Enviroservice Station at 101 Broadview Road, Sherwood Park.

What about the stakes?

Metal stakes are easily recycled at the Broadview Enviroservice Station. Wooden stakes are not recommended as they are not recyclable.

Everyone loves free give aways! How can I make mine last?

Purchase items made from recycled products or that are compostable. Avoid the junk drawer - give away items people will actually use.
