In September, I presented a report to the Board of Trustees asking them to consider the significant research that highlights the positive impact of collaboration on student achievement.

Current research strongly supports the notion that regular, embedded collaboration positively affects both student achievement and teacher efficacy.

When teachers collaborate, they engage in critical reflection on their practices, share insights and challenge one another. This process ultimately leads to improved teaching methods and better student outcomes.
